This position will report to the Administration Manager and Head Cultural Interpreter.

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Greeting individuals before the start of the tour
- Escorting groups throughout the interpretive centre and exhibits; providing information about the history and culture
- Guiding outdoor tours to groups interested in the trails, skiing and snowshoeing and sharing points of interests

Education and Experience:

- Minimum Grade 12;
- Minimum of 1 years' experience in dealing with the public;
- Experience working with cash and POS systems an asset;
- CPR/First-Aid certification is an asset.

Necessary Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:
